

## The Holy House of Nazareth at LORETO

he Holy House of Loreto is the first Shrine of international importance dedicated to the Virgin and true Marian heart of Christianity' (John Paul II). The shrine of Loreto in fact preserves the Nazareth house of the Vingin Mary, according to an ancient tradition today proven by historical and archeological research. The earthly dwelling of Mary in Nazareth was composed by two parts: by a grotto dug into the rock, still venerated in the Basilica of the Annunciation in Nazareth, and by a stone room in front of it, made up of three stone walls positioned to enclose the grotto. According to tradition, in 1291, when the crusaders were definitively expelled from Palestine, the brick walls of the house of Our Lady were transported 'through angelic ministry', first to Illyria (at Trsat, in present Croatia) and then to the territory of Loreto (December 10, 1294). There were also found some remains of an ostrich egg, which immediately recalls Palestine and a symbolism referring to the mystery of the Incarnation. Moreover the Holy House, due to its structure and its store material not available in the area, is an artifact foreign to the culture and to the construction styles of the Marche region. On the other hand the technical companisons of the Holy House with the Grotto of Nazareth have highlighted the coexistence and the continuity of the two parts. Of great importance in confirming the tradition is a recent study about the way in which stones are processed, namely according to the procedure of the Nabatteans, common in Galilee at the time of Jesus. Of great interest are also the numerous graffitti engraved on the stores of the Hely House, judged by the experted as being of definite Judeo-Christian origin and very similar to those encountered in Nazarest. The marble covering, surrounding the walls of the Holy House, was requested by Julius II and built with the design of Bramante (1507) and other renowned artists of the Italian Renaissance. The statue of the Virgin with the Baby, in wood of Lebanese cedar, replaces the one of the XIV century, destroyed by a fire in 1921. Famous artists continued through the centuries to embellish the Shrine whose same has rapidly spread in the whole world becoming a privileged destination for millions of pilgrims. The distinguished relic of the Holy House of Mary is an occasion and invitation for the pilgrim to meditate the great theological and spiritual messages linked to the mystery of the Incarnation and to the message of Salvation. Of the three original walls, the lower sections, to aimost three meters in height, are composed mostly of stone rows, principally sandstone retraceable to Nazareth, and the upper sections added subsequently, and thus spurious, are in local bricks, the only building materials used in the area.

APPARITIONS AND MARIAN SHRINES IN THE WORLD

> Numerous Popes have gone on pilgrimage to Loreto and their devotion has always been strong; Popes Pius II and Paul II turned to the Virgin to heal miraculously from their serious illnesses Pope Benedict XV (1914-1922) in consideration of the translation of her house, from Palestine to Loreto, proclaimed Our Lady of Loreto patron of aviators. Loreto is considered the Italian Lourdes and many pilgrimages of the sick are organized every year, with group ceremonies like those that occur at Lourdes.

> The miracles that have taken place through the years are truly numerous, recognized and examined by the medical office of the Shrine. We recall the healing in 1986 of Gerry De Angelis, an Il year-old of San Benedetto. Upon returning from a school trip, Gerry, already of poor health, contracted a severe pneumonia treated with an expectorant that provoked in him an anaphylactic shock. The young boy was hospitalized in coma at the Salesi Hospital of Ancona. His parents made the explicit requests to the doctors to ale three hose most enting heal had occurred, in which case they wanted to take him back home. A phone call a rurved to them a few days later, in which the doctors to did them to go immediately because there was nothing more to do for Gerry. It is Gerry's fisher himself to tell what happened: "In proximity of Loreto it manifested like a force that guided me. I exited the highway and went to the Shrine. I knelt in front of the Virigin Mary and in my heart I heard a voice repeating to me that Gerry was healing. It was so convincing that it make the overcome the pain and the anguish of those moments. When I entered the hospital I saw that they were removing the machine from Gerry. Since half an hour, in fact, he had come out of the coma and was improving. The doctors had told us that only a miracle could have saved him." While for Lorenzo Rossi, of 9 months, who was testified as dead in 1959: after being anointed with the oil of the lamp that burned in the Holy House, he had recovered rapidly. Finally an elderly woman healed from a miotic macular hole in the retina, who during prayer in front of the image of Our Lady of Loreto felt "healed". In fact she regained prefect sight (it must be noted that one does not heal from the pathologies to the retina because the retina does not regenerate).
